# Subject: Power Plant Update - WE NEED YOU ON THURSDAY

# There is something happening this Thursday that might prove to be our single best opportunity to stop the power plant. WE NEED YOU!

There will be a public hearing in Hartford this Thursday March 18th at 2:00 pm. Senator Musto, Rep. T.R. Rowe, and Rep. Tony Hwang are proposing a bill that will allow the Siting Council to take into account issues such as public safety. *Today, your safety is NOT even a valid issue the Council can even consider!* 

- It is critical to have a large presence at the hearing.
- We need residents and families to be there to demonstrate support for this legislation. Just showing up in person will make a powerful statement - to the company, to the utility, and to Connecticut lawmakers - that Trumbull opposes this power plant.
- Residents may testify at the hearing - but that is NOT necessary. In fact, having a room full of residential opposition is far more important than having a long list of speakers.
